Are you a Ghanaian Journalist? Do you write stories or generate media content on the following areas in healthcare delivery?



BEST REPORTING ON MALARIA

This category looks at stories that explore access to health care, medical quality and costs, as well as decisions about malaria health care made by government and other stakeholders.



BEST WASH AWARENESS REPORT

Stories that expose the real challenges communities have with Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH) and push duty bearers to act and also create awareness on WASH towards achieving behavioural changes.

MOST IMPACTFUL STORY ON HIV/AIDS

This category looks at stories that delve into difficult issues regarding HIV/AIDS, procedures or tests, access to drugs and stigma. How impactful the story is in directing policy, and or bringing about behavioural changes.



BEST NUTRITION REPORT

Stories that focus on breastfeeding, weaning, and also on school feeding. Topics might include whether communities have access to healthy foods and are conscious of healthy eating and wellbeing.





SPECIAL MATERNAL HEALTH AND FAMILY PLANNING REPORT

Stories that reveal the vulnerabilities among women and children, access to quality health care without any form of victimization. The stories that also look at policy direction, maternal health issues within our localities, seek to improve the quality of health care for pregnant women and children.



MOST IMPACTFUL P4H REPORTER

This award goes to a reporter who has contributed immensely and consistently to the P4H project in terms of writing stories on all five thematic areas (Malaria, HIV/AIDS, WASH, Nutrition, and Maternal Health and Family Planning) aimed at promoting access to quality health care and reducing the inequities that exists in health care delivery for vulnerable groups in P4H communities.
