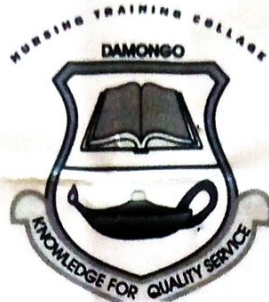

**SECOND PETITION TO THE SCHOOL MANAGEMENT AND STAKEHOLDERS**

As you may be aware that the Students Representative Council SRC is a board managing, supervising and effectively running the affairs and duties of the board by the student representatives and other selected stakeholders of every adult educational institution, for this reason, SRC is expected to work in harmony under one umbrella with the administration and as well as share ideas towards building and making the noble profession better and straightening the curves that has come to their notice. In line with this, SRC can't work productively and progressively without the aid and support of the administration. However, the SRC in collaboration with the entire student body of Nurse Training College – Damongo wishes to bitterly express their sorrowful grievances and challenges **for immediate address**. Permit me to spell out, or perhaps remind you of the numerous neglected petitions SRC sent to the school administration that deeply affects the students and the school negatively

On the 17<sup>th</sup> of January, 2022 the SRC wrote a letter requesting to have a meeting with school management after been elected into office as new SRC executives and also to discuss issues and

to some social amenities such as water which we rather buy after paying for it in their admission fees and the most worrying of all is that, students send mattresses out at night and sleep on the floor rather than on beds due to mass number of continue students and freshers in the various dormitories. It's very pathetic to see how students served food when is time for dining , students served food on the floor which several complaints has been made but all the responses was we will look at it nothing else, as health institution we cannot practice hygiene how can we educate our community members on personal and environment hygiene. In this school all over the place is dusty and imagine serving food on the floor the kind of infection students are picking in the course of sharing the food. We are not any way against management either asking management to solve all the problems at once but at least something must be done about it; we are informing all stakeholders to intervene before we take actions.



challenges affecting the SRC board and the school but NO response was given to this, besides that, the SRC made several follow-ups on the meeting request but it resulted into nothing.

On the **14<sup>th</sup> February, 2022** a proposal letter was sent to the school management in request of fund from the SRC account been managed by the school management which shouldn't have been so, to embark on the SRC project for 2021-2022 academic year which include

- Repairing of the broken lovers' benches on campus
- Purchasing of music system which the school lacks for decades
- Mounting of new sign board at the school entrance which the school do not have

In request of this, NO response nor attention was paid and several excuses were given by the management that "THERE IS NO MONEY" The question bordering students is that, what is the money of SRC been used for? And for any reason, SRC executives should be consulted and informed in any expenses from the SRC account.

To add to that, on the **22<sup>nd</sup> February, 2022**. A petition letter was sent to the management after sacking students from lectures and denying students food from the school dining even for making 79% payment of the entire school fees unless 80%, this practice has been in place for barely three months now and even in this month of Ramadhan, so you can image the hardship and horrible time Muslim students will be facing and other religious groups. A week after that, the SRC made follow up for the response of the *petition letter but nothing was achieved*, a lot of questions asking by the students that if they make full payment is the management going to give their food the school has denied all this while which SRC executives was told that is form of punishment for paying school fees late. School do not have sound system for quite number of years not less than 3years but students are paying for sports and entertainment which management has turn deaf ears to our complaints. There is a lot of issues which we wouldn't capture everything but few of them has been captured.

Furthermore, On the **5<sup>th</sup> April, 2022**, SRC executives made a move and met the Principal of the school several times to find out the reason for the delay in respond to the numerous letters served to the administration, but only to hear from the principal that "there is no money for SRC and that they have used it". It's unfortunate we couldn't quote all what was said to us because of how hurting the words are. As you read now, level hundred students were recently admitted into the college and parents are in their homes thinking that they have paid their wards admission fees and so they should be having access
